I agree to abide by all rules and regulations of this competition.

BASIC COMPETITION RULES

1. The Inter-Club Competition will be judged by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of the competition with certain modifications appearing below and in the expanded Inter-Club Rules & Regulations which will be made available to your club's AOCNC liaison.
2. A dog must be handled by its owner or a member of the immediate family.
3. The same Exhibitor must handle the dog in all individual exercises in the class.
4. A dog that appears threatening to or attacks a person or another dog will be expelled from the grounds and any scores earned will be revoked.
5. Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in a ring for judging.
6. A dog that fouls the ring will be assessed penalty points but may continue to compete.
7. All scores count toward club total scores. Awards are earned based on the highest aggregate scores for each award. Separate awards are given for Obedience and Rally. There are no awards for the combination of Obedience and Rally.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Members of AOCNC clubs, their trainers and their trainees are eligible to enter, with the following restriction - anyone who is a trainer or trainee with one club, but is a member of another club, must show for their member club. An exhibitor may represent only one club.
2. Eligibility to be determined as of DATE ENTRIES CLOSE (see other side of flyer).
3. Eligibility (equivalent to):

Novice	No Novice legs through 2 Open legs	No Novice legs through 2 Advance legs
Open/Advanced	CD through 2 UD legs	RN through 2 RA legs
Utility/Excellent	CDX or higher	RA or higher
UDX/RAE	UD (must enter Utility, may also enter Open)	RA (must enter Excellent, may also enter Advanced)

4. A dog may be entered in a maximum of 4 regular competitive classes (2 obedience and 2 rally.)
