BASIC COMPETITION RULES

1. The Inter-Club non-competitive classes will be judged by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of the event with certain modifications appearing below and in the expanded Inter-Club Rules & Regulations which are available at www.aocnc.org. Club coordinator is responsible for dissemination of information to the club's participants.
2. A dog must be handled by its owner or a member of the immediate family.
3. Scores earned in non-competitive classes will not count toward club team awards.
4. A dog may be entered in competitive classes and non-competitive classes. It is not necessary to enter competitive classes in order to enter non-competitive classes.
5. A dog that appears threatening to or attacks a person or another dog will be expelled from the grounds and any scores earned will be revoked.
6. Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in a ring for judging.
7. A dog that fouls the ring will be assessed penalty points but may continue to compete.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Members of AOCNC clubs, their trainers and their trainees are eligible to enter, with the following restriction - anyone who is a trainer or trainee with one club, but is a member of another club, must enter with their member club. An exhibitor may only enter with one club.
2. Any dog may enter any non-competitive class.
