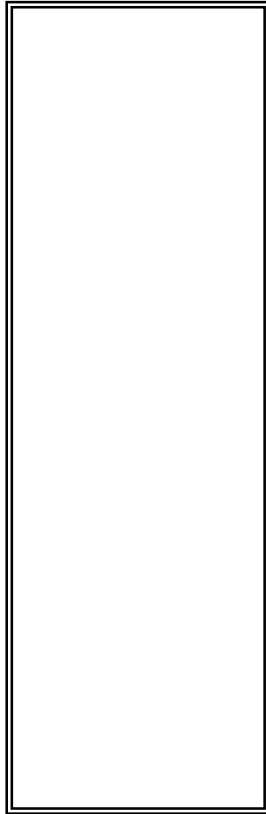

TDX ENTRY FEE: \$90.00 (including \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee).

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 p.m. Thursday, March 4, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed.

This test will be limited to 4 dogs. Entries will be accepted until the closing date, even though the limit has been reached. Test participants will be selected from all entries by a random drawing. When the limit is reached, the drawing will continue and an alternate list established in the order in which entries are drawn.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: The drawing will be held, Friday, March 5, 2010, at 1:30 PM, at Test Secretary's home at 1118 Summit Lake Drive, Angwin, CA. Notification of draw results will be mailed within four (4) days after the drawing. Should the exhibitors not receive such notification within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

TDX ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must have earned the TD title to be eligible to enter the TDX Test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the TDX title. However, dogs not holding a TDX title shall be given priority for entry in the test by the Tracking Test Secretary

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and compliance with all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee will be refunded in the following cases: (1) If the entrant notifies the Test Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test, and an alternate is available to run the track; or (2) for an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

The **HEALTH AND SAFETY** of the dogs, exhibitors, judges and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs.

TDX TRACK DRAWING for running order will be held at the Test site at 9:30 AM. The test judging will begin when tracks have aged sufficiently. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

TROPHIES: Each team passing this test will receive an acrylic frame with a map of their track and a photo of them with the Judges.

LUNCHEON will be provided for exhibitors and spectators after the test.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE: From Napa, take Silverado Trail north for 18.5 miles. At the intersection of Silverado Trail and Deer Park Road, turn right and proceed on Deer Park Road for 5.3 miles. At Cold Springs Road, turn right. (Note: if you drive past Pacific Union College you have gone too far!) After driving a short distance through residential area you will come to a Y in the road. Stay to the left and you will be on Las Posadas Road. Continue straight on Las Posadas Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles bearing right as the road curves. Approximately 1/2 mile further look for the Forest Service Office on the left-hand side. There is also a 4-H camp at this location so keep an eye out for signs for the 4-H camp.

NO PRACTICING IS ALLOWED AT THE TEST SITE.
