**CLOSING DATE:** Entries will be accepted until Wednesday, February 22, 2012, 6:00 PM, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$125.00 US (Includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee)

**ELIGIBILITY:** This test is for dogs that have earned the AKC Tracking Dog (TD) title. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the VST title; however, the Test Secretary will give priority to entries for dogs that do not hold a VST title. This test will be limited to 4 dogs. Entries will be accepted until the closing date, even though the limit has been reached. Test participants will be selected from all entries by a random drawing. When the limit is reached, the drawing will continue and an alternate list established in the order in which entries are drawn.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and compliance with all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

**DRAW FOR ENTRY** will be held on Thursday, February 23, 2012, 6:00 PM at the Test Secretary's home, 1118 Summit Lake Drive, Angwin, CA.

**ALTERNATES:** An alternate list shall be maintained. It will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

**NOTIFICATION:** Results of the draw will be sent by email if an e-mail address is provided on the Entry Form. The draw results and a judging schedule also will be sent by US Postal Mail within 48 hours of the draw. Should the exhibitors and alternates not receive such notification, please contact the Test Secretary.

**REFUND POLICY:** The entry fee will be refunded in the following cases:  
(1) If the entrant notifies the Test Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test, and an alternate is available to run the track; or (2) for an entrant or alternate who is not given an opportunity to run a track.

The **HEALTH AND SAFETY** of the dogs, exhibitors, judges and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions.

**DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER:** All entrants must be at the Test Headquarters at 9:30 AM for track drawing. The test will begin when the first track has aged sufficiently. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent by the Judges and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

**TEST HEADQUARTERS:** The Lakeside Grill at Vintner's Golf Club, 7901 Solano Avenue, Yountville, CA 94599.

**DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS:** From Napa, take Hwy 29 North to the town of Yountville. Take the Veteran's Home exit, go under the freeway, and make the first left onto Solano Avenue. You will see the clubhouse on the right. Park at the south end of the parking lot near the fire station.

**AWARDS:** Each passing team will receive an acrylic frame with a map of their track and a photo of them with the Judges.

**LUNCHEON:** Following the test there will be a no-host lunch at the Lakeside Grill, Vintner's Golf Club, 7901 Solano Avenue, Yountville, CA. All are welcome!

**INSTRUCTIONS**

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth) Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions is Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State or entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11 Section 3.)
